

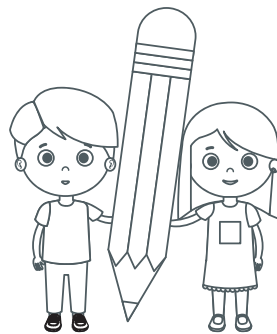

Each book features:

1. **Rich content:** including Scripture, hymns, poetry and more
2. **A gentle approach:** each book presents enough material to challenge the student without becoming overwhelming
3. **An opportunity to review:** Your child will write the words that he reads, which provides an opportunity for him to build his vocabulary and reading fluency.
4. **A spacious design:** each page offers plenty of space for your child to practice his best handwriting

How to use your Lutheran Children's Copybook & Reader:

1. Print & bind one copy for each student who will be using the copybook.
2. Begin with the first passage in the book, read through the passage together (it is suggested to read the passage aloud first, while the child listens; then read the passage line-by-line and ask the child to repeat each line.)
3. Once the child is familiar with the first passage he may begin his copy work. The copybook uses a gentle approach to writing and prioritizes a quality over quantity approach. It is recommended to ask your child to copy one page per day, using only his best handwriting. Ask your child to make any necessary corrections until he has satisfactorily copied the page.
4. Each day ask your child to read the page he will copy aloud, then he will copy that page.
5. At end of the copy pages the passage will appear once again in full for your child to read and review.
6. Repeat steps 1-5 with each passage in the book. Once your child has copied all of the pages in the copybook, you are ready for the next volume!
